

### National Surveillance Centre Dashboards and Monitoring Medicine Availability


- The National Surveillance Centre provides visibility of medicine availability (https://medssc.co.za/)
- KPIs at health establishment, district, provincial level, national and supplier level
- Data visualised from the **Stock Visibility System**, **RxSolution**, **Warehouse Management Systems**, electronic stock management systems in use by suppliers and other sources
- Provides **updated information to enable evidence-based decision making** to support medicine supply management and medicine availability
  - Identification and mitigation of supply chain issues
  - Effective implementation of stock-out escalation protocols





## National Surveillance Centre Dashboards and Monitoring Medicine Availability

#### Examples of views that should be monitored:



PTCs should monitor dashboards at least weekly to identify supply interruptions at health establishments.

What to look out for:

- Items out of stock
- Stock below minimum level
- Average stock levels
- Supplier pipeline for stock



## National Surveillance Centre Dashboards and Monitoring Medicine Availability

Root cause of identified challenges - implementation of corrective and preventive interventions

Review and update health establishment customised formulary

Correction of master data or stock availability related data

Movement of stock between health establishments

**Recommendation of alternative pack sizes or dosage strengths** 

**Recommendation of therapeutic alternatives/interchange** 

Training of stock managers
