THE JOURNEY TO SUCCESS:

□ National Vaccination Programme -Circular 03/2023

- Children 5-11 years old at risk of severe Covid -19 disease have become eligible to receive two doses of the Comirnaty Paediatric vaccine.
- Covid -19 vaccination for children was started in a phased approach, starting with implementation at selected central, regional and district hospitals followed by expansion to include primary care facilities.

Eligibility:

-Children with chronic heart, respiratory, neurological, kidney, liver or gastrointestinal conditions, as well as immunosuppression and serious genetic abnormalities that effect a number of systems will be legible and should be offered vaccination in the public sector.

Required Documents :

-Parent/Caregiver identification document

-Clients birth certificate needed


